

Polk Township was very fortunate to receive \$100,696 from the Cares Act. Since the township had partnered with the Red Cross to use the township hall as a 2nd level evacuation center and parked the Red Cross truck in the township garage, it enabled the township to purchase certain items that would benefit the Red Cross and the township as well.

The items purchased by the Cares Act money are the following: a new roof over the garage, a generator, electronic sign to replace the sign we had, UV lights for purifying the air in the meeting hall and office, hand sanitizers outside the bathrooms, EZ electrostatic handheld sprayer, and vital oxide cleaner to sanitize the inside of the equipment to protect the road employees, iPad and software for zoning inspector and various other cleaning equipment and sanitizers to keep visitors and those who rent the hall as safe as possible.

We feel very blessed that we were able to purchase the above-mentioned items for the township which will not only serve the Red Cross, but our community as well.
